The Town of Lincoln intends to sell a 2010 Ford Crown Victoria, 4 door sedan. This vehicle is a former patrol car of the Lincoln Police Department. Approximate mileage is 170,000. The Lincoln Town Council, acting through its Town Manager, reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids in whole or in part, and to waive any informalities the Town may determine necessary.

Additional Information; This car is the oldest in the fleet with approximately 170,000 miles. Kelley Blue Book values the car in fair condition at \$3,109. I did include the Kelley Blue Book value in good condition to be \$3,482. NADA Guides places the value for average trade in at \$2,625. The average value between the three is \$3,072.
