Additional Information; GVWR of 35,000 pounds. This unit is equipped with a 2,500-gallon water tank. The unit has a 300hp Caterpillar Turbo-diesel motor with an Allison 5-speed automatic transmission. It should be **CLEARLY NOTED** that the fire apparatus, fire pump, and chassis components are in need of **significant** repairs. Therefore, this vehicle will **NOT** be conveyed as a piece of fire apparatus to be used as an active-duty suppression vehicle.
