Additional Information; This unit had been assigned to the Lincoln Fire Department for many years but is no longer needed as equipment needs have been upgraded. This particular generator was built by H.K. Porter Company, Esecos Division, Joliet, Illinois. The generator does not run as electrical work would need to be performed and possibly generator maintenance. The age of the unit is approximately 50 to near 60 years old and is mounted on a mobile trailer, complete with towing arm.
